

The conference was held from March 29th to March 31st, 2024, with 89 attendants. That is 38 students and 37 adults. We also had 14 children in attendance. The theme of the conference was “You are loved,” based on 1 John 3:1. God raised six messengers among the local shepherds: one life testimony sharer and one representative testimony sharer. The conference commenced with an opening message from 1 John 3:1–3 by Sh. Isaac Byarugaba. There were three main lectures; 1, 2, and 3 from Isaiah 61:1–11, Luke 23:26–43, and Matthew 28:1–15, respectively. The messengers were Sh. Julius Ecuru for the main lecture I, Sh. James Muhindo for the main lecture II and Sh. Albert Ovon for the main Lecture III. We also had two morning devotions on March 30th and 31st from Mark 9:30–32 and Phil 2:1–11 by Sh. Calvin Kitembo and Sh. Lucy Sejjemba, respectively.
